Application of H C Boydston No. 5540

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary <sup>(on Parole)</sup> 2nd Degree

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 18th day of Jan A. D. 1931, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in 2nd District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Eugene E. Pratt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one to twenty yrs

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison from Jan 18 1931 to June 12 1932 since then I have been on Parole

Fourth-Honorable David T Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Guy Wayne Roberts.

I was convicted under the name of H. C. Boydston

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as record shows

The reason I am asking for this action is so I may go to Nevada where I may find Employment
