I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a conditional termination
(to return to my home at Burbank, Calif.)
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the States Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of second degree burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 24 day of June
A. D. 1928, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in the second district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge George S. Barker, presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison of Utah.

Fourth-Honorable Joseph E. Evans, prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Herbert C. Boydston.
I was convicted under the name of Herbert C. Boydston.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except the charge
of which I am now serving.
