I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination & Parole
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of January
A. D. 1931, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in the 2nd District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Eugene E. Pratt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one to twenty years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable David J. Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Guy Wayne Roberts.

I was convicted under the name of H. C. Boydston.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: none

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Wright act
possession, misdemeanor, Los Angeles Calif. - 1926
served 60 days, Ogden, Utah, June - 1928 sentenced
to one to twenty years, charge 2nd Degree burglary
served one year, Utah State Prison.
