Application of Walter Hansen No. 5059

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 26th day of Aug
A. D. 1928, at Bingham City Utah County of Boulder
and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable William C. Harris presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Wesley Forsberg prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Walter Hansen
I was convicted under the name of Walter Hansen

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows:

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except once before
on a similar charge.
