Application of Noble Hansen No. 5059

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in On Parole under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd degree burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 28th day of August A. D. 1928, at Brigham City County of Box Elder and State of Utah, in First Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Harris presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison Paroled April 20, 1930

Fourth-Honorable J. Wesley Horsley prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Noble Hansen I was convicted under the name of Noble Hansen

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None
