Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 28 day of June

and State of Utah, in Fourth Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Elias Hanson presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to one & ten years.

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth--Honorable M. B. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Brigham Warren Mecham

I was convicted under the name of William Warren Mecham

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except Horse Stealing  
And Took it for an Example And Have Not Stolen  
any Thing Since And Think The Jury Naturally  
Thought Me Guilty Because I Fell Before The Prosecuting
