Application of Antonio Rojas No. 4993

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination for Deportation to Mexico, and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 3rd Degree

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of March, A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from 6 months to 3 yrs. and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Antonio Rojas, I was convicted under the name of same.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.
