Application of Salvador Cardenas No. 5067

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination for Deportation and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Highway Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of September A. D. 1928, at Brigham City County of Box Elder and State of Utah, in First Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Lucius Hansen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from five years to life and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable LeRoy B. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Salvador Cardenas I was convicted under the name of Salvador Cardenas

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Roberto Baraja, Virente Alvarez.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except the above
