I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination for Deportation and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of Septamber A. D. 1928, at Brigham City, County of Box Elder and State of Utah, in First Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Melvin C. Harris, presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable John Horrace J. M. Horrace prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is S. A. Cardenas I was convicted under the name of S. A. Cardenas

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: M. Barajas and B. Alvarez.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
