Application of Charles Monroe 4570

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary Second Degree

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of May A. D. 1925, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge McCrea presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to an indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth--Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is E. H. Burlingham I was convicted under the name of Charles Monroe

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except I have served time in other states
