To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Prohibition law violation

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of October  
A. D. 1926, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in 3<sup>rd</sup> District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Dist. Judge Chris Mathison presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to not less than 3 Month and not more  
than 1 year  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison Oct. 14 - 1926

Fourth-- Honorable Deputy Dist. Atty. J. G. Clawson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Frank Kunz  
I was convicted under the name of Frank Kunz alias Frank Wilson

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: none

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except December 1916  
4<sup>th</sup> District Court 3<sup>rd</sup> degree Burglary. 5 Months
