Application of Edward Moody No. 5005

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 6th day of April
A. D. 1928, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in 2nd. District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge J.M. Kimball presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to serve an indeterminate sentence in the Utah
State Prison
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Joseph Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Edward Moody
I was convicted under the name of same

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Jack Ryan

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except none

*And I can truthfully say that I am not
guilty of this charge of first degree Burglary.
The prosecution showed no evidence to convict me
of first degree. My record will show that I have
never been accused of a felony.*
