Application of Jack Leon Milton

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Set Date Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First -- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second degree Burglary

Second -- I was convicted and sentenced on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of Sept A. D. 1926, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable S. E. Evans presiding.

Third -- I was sentenced to Serve one to twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth -- Honorable Judge Kimball prosecuted the case.

Fifth -- My true name in full is George Louis Milton I was convicted under the name of Jack Leon Milton.

Sixth -- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh -- I have never been convicted of any offense except Alcatraz Island, Folsom Prison, Buena Vista Colo, Salem Ore, Santa Fe New Mexico,
