Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the ninth day of Feb. A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Ritchie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 1 to 5 - (one to five) years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
