Application of James Lindsay McCarty No. 4974

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th day of February A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from one to five years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is James Lindsay McCarty I was convicted under the name of James Lindsay McCarty
