First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment ~~on~~ on Parole under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 1st day of May A. D. 1926, at Salt Lake City, Utah County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Chris Mathison presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to an indeterminate term ~~of from one to ten years~~ and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Samuel G. Clawson prosecuted the case.
