I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Rehabilitation
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Highway Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 12 day of September
A. D. 1928, at Brigham County of Beaver
and State of Utah, in the second district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge M. C. Harris presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to five years to life

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison at
Salt Lake City, Utah

Fourth-Honorable L. Ray B. Young prosecuted the case.
