County and State aforesaid, Honorable M.C. Harris presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable LeRoy B. Young prosecuted the case.

I was convicted under the name of Same.
