

Salt Lake City, Utah, March 15, 1930

Application of Vincente Alvarez No. 5066

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a deportation to Mexico and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of highway robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 10 day of September A. D. 1928, at Brigham County of Bogalder and State of Utah, in the first second district court Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge M. C. Harris presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to five years to life at the state prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the in the State Prison at Salt Lake City

Fourth-Honorable LeRoy P. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Vincente Alvarez I was convicted under the name of Vincente Alvarez

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: N. Barajas, Salvadora Cardenas

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except this charge of highway robbery
