Application of Jack Ryan No. 5006

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of First Degree Burglary.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the Sixth day of April A. D. 1922, at Ogden, County of Weber and State of Utah, in the Second District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Kimball presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 25 to 40 Years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Joseph Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Jack Ryan I was convicted under the name of Jack Ryan.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Edward Moody.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except.
