Application of Jack Ryan No. 5006

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of First Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the sixth day of April  
A. D. 1928, at Ogden County of Weber  
and State of Utah, in The Second Judicial Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Kumble presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 25 to 40 years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.
