Application of Jim D. Woods No. 5064

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of second degree burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 8th day of September
A. D. 1928, at Ogden County of Weber

and State of Utah, in second district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge George S. Barker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one to twenty years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison at
Salt Lake, Sugar House.

Fourth-Honorable Joseph C. Evans prosecuted the case.
