Application of James Phillips No. 4795

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence  
(Conditional to Denver, Colo.)  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Rape

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 11th day of December,  
A. D. 1926, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Chris Mathison presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth--Honorable S. G. Clawson prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is James Phillips  
I was convicted under the name of James Phillips

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: None.

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
