Application of Samuel Callasco #4667.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th day of February  
A. D. 1926, at Salt Lake City, Utah County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable William S. Marks presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence of from 5 years  
to life,  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable Samuel G. Clawson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Samuel Callasco  
I was convicted under the name of Samuel Callasco

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the crime for which I am  
now serving.
