Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th day of February

and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Wm. L. Markes presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
