Application of Claude Blackburn

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of theft of an automobile

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the seventeenth day of Febr. A. D. 1927, at Provo County of Utah and State of Utah, in Fourth District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge ~~James~~ <sup>Bozinger</sup> presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to a term of not less than one and not greater than ten years in State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison at Salt Lake City

Fourth-- Honorable M. B. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Claude Blackburn I was convicted under the name of Claude Blackburn

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Harry Nelson, Clayton Munnman.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except This One.
