and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Auto Theft

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of March  
A. D. 1926, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Wm. S. Marks presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Mr. Clawson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Malloye Joseph Jensen  
I was convicted under the name of Malloye Jensen

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: Harry Edwards, Burt Hansen.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except a charge of Grand Larceny,  
for which I served six months in the Salt Lake County Jail.
