I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of highway robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 4 day of April
A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Ethell Hanson presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 5 years to life

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State prison

Fourth-Honorable William Duncan prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Will McDaniel
I was convicted under the name of Will McDaniel

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Frank James

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as record
shows
