Application of Will McDaniel No. 5013

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 12 day of April
A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake Utah County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Ephraim Hanson presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to five years to life
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable W. A. Bunchan prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Will McDaniel.

I was convicted under the name of Will McDaniel.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Frank James.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as Record Book
