County and State aforesaid, Honorable G. Christenson presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to six months to three years.

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah state prison

Fourth-Honorable F. W. Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Robert Burns Harold
