Application of Alex Pinzk

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of sentence
and respectfully represent as follows:

First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of second degree burglary

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the fifth day of April
A. D. 1926, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable William S. Marks presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to an indeterminate term not to exceed twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth--Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Alex Domansky
I was convicted under the name of Alex Pinzk

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: none

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except
a similar offense in Washington.
