and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable William S. Marks. presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Sentence of one to ten years,  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable S. G. Clawson. prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Antonio Martinez.  
I was convicted under the name of Antonio Martinez.
