Application of Andrew Kouligas

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Commutation of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 1st degree murder

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Eighteenth day of June A. D. 1922, at Price County of Carbon and State of Utah, in 7th Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. E. Woods, presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Life and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Judge Dalton prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Andrew Kouligas I was convicted under the name of Sam.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None.

Am naturalized American Citizen: Served 21 months in Army. 11 months in France.
