I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Commutation of Sentence  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Murder 1st Degree

Second --I was convicted and sentenced on the 16th day of June  
A. D. 1922, at Price, County of Carbon  
and State of Utah, in the Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable F. E. Woods presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Life imprisonment

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable B. W. Dalton prosecuted the case.

Fifth -- My true name in full is Andrew Koulikas  
I was convicted under the name of Andrew Koulikas

Sixth -- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
