under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attempted Murder.

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 23rd day of March  
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Oscar W. McConkie presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,  
  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth--Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Ralph Short  
I was convicted under the name of Ralph Short

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except none.
