Application of Ralph Short No. 5170

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attempted Murder

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 23rd day of March
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in 2nd District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Oscar W. McConkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to Twenty Years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Calvin W. Rawlins prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Chas. Ralph Short
I was convicted under the name of Ralph Short

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Dewey Short
