Application of Thomas Davis 4731

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 26th day of July A. D. 1926, at Fillmore County of Millard and State of Utah, in Fifth Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Thomas H. Burton presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable George H. Lunt prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Thomas Davis I was convicted under the name of Thomas Davis

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: S. B. Grammelt

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None
