Application of Joseph O. Helwig.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a conditional termination (to go HOME.) and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attempted Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 25 day of October A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge E. Hanson presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate period and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Attorney Mr. Vancott, prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Joseph Oscar Helwig I was convicted under the name of Joseph O. Helwig

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Jerry Ribblet

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as shown on record
