I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a conditional termination--go, back to Ohio
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attempted Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 20th. day of October
A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Ephraim Hanson presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to An Indeterminate term of from one to twenty
years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable E. A. Rogers Dist. Att. prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Joseph Oscar Helwig

I was convicted under the name of J. O. Helwig
