First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Penitentiary  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attornied Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 26th day of October  
A. D. 1918, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in The Third Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Ebraia Hansen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term not to exceed five  
years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Penitentiary

Fourth-Honorable A. A. Hanson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Joseph G. Helwig  
I was convicted under the name of Joseph G. Helwig
