First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Penitentiary  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 22 day of March  
A. D. 1929, at Ogden County of Kane  
and State of Utah, in 2 Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Barker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to a term of from one to twenty years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Penitentiary
