Application of Jean Devorasse No. 4305

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of second degree burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 6th day of November A. D. 1923, at Richfield County of Sevier and State of Utah, in seventh district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge V. Erickson presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of not less than one year, nor more than twenty years, and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Niphi J. Bates prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Verne Jean Devorasse

I was convicted under the name of Jean Devorasse

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Robert Clark

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as shown on prison records, which was larceny in Iowa, in 1920, and second degree burglary in Minnesota, in 1924.
