Application of Carl Siler No. 5008

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of April  
A. D. 1928, at Kanab County of Kane  
and State of Utah, in Seventh District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable N. J. Bates presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to From One to Ten years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Hockett Knox prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Carl Ezra Siler  
I was convicted under the name of Carl E. Siler

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: Accl. Palmer

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except None  
I was brought back on Parole  
Violation on the 13<sup>th</sup> of June 1929
