Application of JOHN CERAR

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a COMMUTATION
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Murder First Degree

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of November
A. D. 1921, at Price County of Carbon
and State of Utah, in Seventh Judicial Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable F. E. Woods presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Death, (Which sentence was commuted to life
imprisonment on August 22nd, 1922)
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable B. W. Dalton prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is John Cerar
I was convicted under the name of John Cerar

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except this one
