Application of John Cerar

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison.  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Murder 1st Degree

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 12th day of November,  
A. D. 1921, at Price, County of Carbon  
and State of Utah, in the Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable E. E. Woods presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Life.  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Mr. Dalton prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is John Cerar  
I was convicted under the name of John Cerar

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: None.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.

Note: I was commuted to 20 years on December 18th, 1926.
