Application of John Cerar No. 3993

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Murder 1st Degree.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 12th day of November A. D. 1921, at Price County of Carbon and State of Utah, in 7th Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Woods presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Life, then commuted to 20 years. and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable B. W. Dalton prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is John Cerar I was convicted under the name of Same

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except None Other
