Application of William J. Quibell No. 5090.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a parole  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 23 day of October  
A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in 3rd District Criminal Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Ephraim Hanson presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to serve an indeterminate  
term of 1 to 10 years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable E. D. Rodgers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is William Jos. Quibell

I was convicted under the name of William J. Quibell

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Grand larceny  
and served in the Utah State Industrial  
School.
