First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Gambling

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 20th day of September
A. D. 1930, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in 3rd Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Moffet presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to serve not more than
five years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable S. Rawlings prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is William Joseph Quibell
I was convicted under the name of Wm. J. Quibell

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except
Grand Larceny
