I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the September  
A. D. 1930, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Moffett presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence of not  
more than five years and Parole Violation  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
