and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 1st Degree

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 23 day of January
A. D. 1933, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in 3rd Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge McHenry presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Serve and Indeterminate Sentence
of one to twenty years (and parole violation)
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Att. Leavin Paulsen prosecuted the case.
